NOTE TO THE CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR

1. This document covers all work that is eligible to be carried out on the building in order to benefit from assistance under the program.
2. If the contractor detects other defects that are not mentioned, the contractor shall, when preparing its estimate specify the corrective work and submit a price for execution of the work. This work must be checked and approved by the inspection agency before being carried out.
3. The contractor is required to check all measurements on-site before doing an estimate.
4. The contractor shall acknowledge and accept that this estimate does not necessarily contain a highly detailed and exhaustive description of the work, but the contractor shall foresee all details, accessories and material normally required to perform finished and complete work for each division.
5. The contractor shall clean, pick up and remove all debris resulting from any demolition work or work involving the installation of new material.
6. As this document is not a contract, the contractor and the owner shall sign, following approval of the application for assistance by the SHQ, a formal contract stating the terms and conditions and giving a more detailed description of the work and any other work not eligible under this program related to the execution of this project.
7. The contractor agrees to comply with the laws governing the construction industry, especially by holding a valid license authorizing the contractor to perform the work specified in the estimate.
8. The contractor must use new materials of at least standard quality.
